Mr. Nolon is a well recognized land use expert and law professor. He trains local officials, environmentalists, and developers in land use law and consensus building techniques, provides strategic assistance to local governments and mediates land use disputes. His program will present innovative land use techniques, new resources and developments in local land use law which have been successful in protecting local communities to enable local government planners and officials to meet new challenges in their own communities.
